

Seattle Preschool Program 2021-2022 - Application Instructions

What is the Seattle Preschool Program?

Seattle Preschool Program (SPP) sites offer high-quality, affordable preschool to children across the City of Seattle. Tuition is free or on a sliding scale and is based on household size and parent/guardian income.

Preschool programs are 6 hours per day, 5 days per week. Flexible schedules, such as part-day or 3 days per week, are not an option. Extended care is available at some sites.

The Seattle Preschool Program is planning for a return to normal programming for the 2021-22 school year. Should COVID-19 persist or require different approaches to the school year, SPP will adjust as needed before school begins.

Who is eligible?

- Children who are age 3 or 4 by August 31, 2021.
- Children who are residents of Seattle. Children residing in unincorporated Seattle, or outside Seattle city limits, are not eligible.
- Staff will not askinformation about immigration status.

When is the application due?

Initial Enrollment Offers: If your application is submitted between March 15 and April 9, 2021, you will be notified about your selection status no later than April 30, 2021.

Waitlist: If your child is not selected and placed initially, or your application is received after April 9, 2021, you will be placed on a waitlist. Vacancies are filled on a rolling basis between April 30, 2021 and March 31, 2022.

Submitting an application does not guarantee your child will be selected for the program.

What are the selection criteria?

- Homeless and Foster Care: Children from families experiencing homelessness and in foster care will receive priority placement.
- Child's age: Children who are age 4 on or before August 31, 2021 will receive priority over children who are age 3.
- Home address: If you select a site that is in the same Seattle Public Schools elementary or middle school attendance zone as your home address, you will receive priority for that site over children living in other parts of the city.
- Siblings: Additional preference is given to children with siblings either enrolled/attending SPP at the same time or attending Seattle Public Schools in the same building.
- Heritage language: Three-year-olds who speak a heritage language with a household income below 350% of the federal poverty level will receive priority over other three-year-olds.
- **Low-Income:** Three-year-olds with a household income below 200% of the federal poverty level will receive priority over other three-year-olds.

SPP partners with schools and childcare providers to offer preschool for 6 hours per day, 5 days per week. Some programs also offer additional hours. Select the program type that is right for your child.


Review and select programs that are acceptable for your child receives an offer. The more locations selected, the greater chance you have of being placed.
