CHILDREN & YOUTH VACCINE UPTAKE



As of February 14, **80.5**[%] of the population 5 and up has **received at least one dose** and **72.7**[%] is **fully vaccinated**.

*This percent includes aggregate data from the Department of Defense and Department of Veterans Affairs and is higher than the DOH data dashboard.

• 5-11 Population

- ~677,743
- 33.4% have received their first dose & 25.6% are fully vaccinated

CHILDREN & YOUTH VACCINE UPDATES

• Who can get vaccinated?

- Everyone ages 5+ can get vaccinated!
- Upcoming 6months-4years*



*The FDA has delayed its meeting for Pfizer's vaccine for kids under 5. The FDA is awaiting additional information regarding the ongoing evaluation of a third dose. Pfizer said they expect to have data on three vaccine doses in early April.

• Which vaccines can they get?

- Pfizer-BioNTech pediatric vaccine is the only available COVID-19 vaccine option for children ages 5 to 17.
- The dosage for ages 5-11 is 1/3 the size of the dosage for used for ages 12+

• Do youth need a booster?

 Currently, booster doses are only recommended for people 12 years and older

Children and Youth Services ^

Provide vaccines to children, ages 5-11

Provide vaccines to youth, ages 12-17

Consent allowed from a foster parent or other person authorized by a court to provide consent to medical care for a child in an out-of-home placement

Consent allowed from a person with signed authorization from parent to make health care decisions

Consent allowed from a relative responsible for health care

Consent allowed from school nurse, counselor, or homeless liaison (for a youth defined as homeless under the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Act)

Consent allowed from youth who are legally emancipated or married to an adult

Consent allowed from youth qualifying under the Mature Minor Doctrine

Verbal consent allowed (over the phone)

Written consent allowed

Parent/Guardian/Authorized adult does not need to be physically present

The COVID-19 vaccine is available to people 5 years of age and older. Youth ages 5 to 17 may get only the Pfizer vaccine. No other COVID-19 vaccine is authorized for people younger than 18.




